This is my Ch A Weekly Planner where I take the weekly work assigned and divide it into daily chunks. I put a lot of time and effort into each subject but it is in no way perfect and each students week is going to look different. This planner should not replace your Challenge A Guide. I recommend weekly reading through the Challenge A guide and comparing it to this planner.

#### Subject by Subject Explanations

**Math** - For Math, we all use different curriculums so I just left a blank for you to fill in a lesson #. I don't include any blanks for tests because this would fall on different days for different students. The Ch A guide also includes these two instructions that I have put on "Day 1" and "Day 4": Memorize new definitions including terms, laws, rules, and properties" and "Bring one problem from your lessons to practice working as a group in seminar".

Latin – Color coded into each day having the following: Reading, vocab cards, exercises, and grammar. I have broken it up so that these sections correlate to each other so I wouldn't have you doing an exercise where you haven't also read the lesson and learned the correct grammar for that exercise. If you are using the Workspace, I have a file on my website (<u>https://henlelatinhelps.wordpress.com/2019/09/18/challenge-a-latin-helps/</u>) that has a Latin schedule specifically for those using the Workspace and would give you the Workspace pages. You may want to consider using that or updating this planner to reflect the workspace pages.

**Research:** Natural Science - The assignments for these are the same every week for 10 weeks. You research, record, write a bibliography and practice. The only thing that changes each week is the topic. If you are interested in block scheduling, my student did this strand all in one day as well as Analogies for Us and LTW. I recommend Latin and Cartography always being split over the 4 days. **Science Fair** is pretty straightforward but there are times I can not put everything in the guide so I highlight in red to see guide for more information. **Biology** is the same every week but changes out body systems. I have draw and label it on each day and I have define the terms on Days 1 - 3.

**Analogies For Us:** You don't even need the planner for this. The consumable workbook you bought breaks it into Day 1, Day 2, Day 3, Day 4. Thanks CC! Fallacy Detective is also pretty straightforward. Just a couple of chapters assigned each week. My son tended to do all of Fallacy Detective in one day.

**LTW**: (Listed in Challenge A guide as "Literature and Writing" I have it as LTW since that is the curriculum we use.) My planner lists the actual page numbers from the LTW student notebook. Most parents choose to photocopy the student workbook since you use it for 3 years. There are also some pages that you use multiple times in the year. If you are looking for guidance on making your own LTW student notebook, I have one on my website https://henlelatinhelps.wordpress.com/ch-a-pdf-versions-of-files/ scroll down to the bottom to the file "Ch-a-Itw-student-notebook-packet-2 On the first day of a new book, I list the book title and then after that I abbreviate it. I also put a "Due Date: " for the student to write in the date that they need to be completed with the book to remind them.

**Cartography:** On the first week of a new area, it will say "Draw and label the countries and capitals" and then on another week, it will say "draw and label countries, capitals and features" I put "features" in red just to point out that it has changed from the previous week otherwise it would be easy to gloss over that something new was added. The assignments are mostly the same each week. I put drawing a map and working on memorizing on every day and then I randomly put geography terms on Day 3 with finishing on Day 4 if needed but Geo terms could be done on any day so you could edit that if needed.

**This planner was created by Henle Latin Helps**. https://henlelatinhelps.wordpress.com/ If sharing the planner, please share the website and not the file directly. This will insure that the person gets the most up to date information.

**Printing** – I have set the Margins to Narrow when creating this planner. That means it may cut off words when you hole punch or spiral bound it. Because it is the 2-day planner, you probably can set the margins back to normal and it will still fit. One idea for printing is to print it double sided and insert it in the middle of guide for each week then you would have the guide instructions and the weekly planner facing each other for each subject.

**Mac Users:** On my website, I have the PDF version of this file. So if this was sent you as a word file and you would like the PDF, go to <u>https://henlelatinhelps.wordpress.com/</u> and then Challenge A Planner and you can get the PDF version.

**Customizing to your Community Day:** I use "Day 1, Day 2, Day 3 and Day 4". If you are using the Word version, you can easily customize this to your actual days of the week. Press "Control H" and that will bring up the Replace option. Find What: Day 1 Replace With: Tues (or whatever your first day after community is). Do this for all 4 days. I do have some "Day 1" mentions in my subject explanations so those might get messed up if you just do a replace all.

**Errors**: I have proofread the schedule against the guide but I am also human who may have missed something so feel free to email me at <u>amanda.craig@gmail.com</u> if there is anything that is incorrect.
